Notes: Smooth and reminiscent of cherries and raspberries. Bright fruit characters with a nice amount of oak-aging.



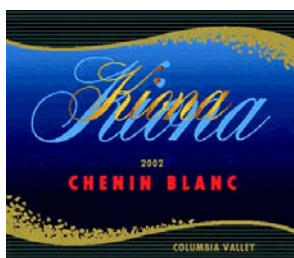

Notes: Delicious, crisp, high-fruit finish with a touch of oak. Serve slightly chilled.



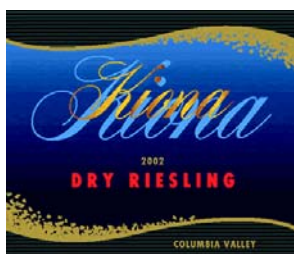
Kiona Chenin Blanc

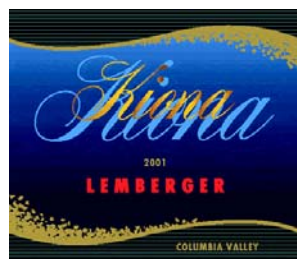
